Description

A beautifully crafted art glass paperweight by Siddy Langley, signed and dated 1999. Compact yet richly expressive, this distinctive studio-glass object demonstrates the colour, depth, and luminous surface effects that make contemporary art glass so compelling.

Formed as a solid glass weight, the piece captures and refracts light through its sculptural body, revealing changing tones and reflections from every angle. Its hand-finished character gives it a presence beyond its practical function, allowing it to work equally well as a decorative object, a collector's piece, or an elegant addition to a desk or writing table.

The signature and date confirm its authorship and place the work firmly within the late 20th-century studio-glass movement, when individual makers were celebrated for combining technical skill with a highly personal approach to colour, form, and surface. Rather than a mass-produced accessory, this is a small work of glass sculpture, created to be handled, viewed, and appreciated in changing light.

A charming and tactile signed piece for collectors of British studio glass, art glass paperweights, or contemporary decorative arts. It would also make a thoughtful gift for a collector, a writer, or anyone drawn to the unique beauty of handmade glass.
