Liberty of London, founded in 1875 by Arthur Lasenby Liberty, became a cornerstone of the Arts and Crafts movement in Britain. The store championed craftsmanship, natural materials, and traditional techniques at a time when mass production was on the rise.

Liberty collaborated with artists and designers such as William Morris, producing exquisite textiles and furnishings that celebrated beauty in everyday life. Its distinctive floral and nature-inspired prints embodied the Arts and Crafts philosophy of harmony between art and design.

The Liberty building itself, with its Tudor revival façade, reflected the movement's respect for heritage, artistry, and enduring quality.
