Description

A striking mid-century plaster bust of Louis XIV, the celebrated "Sun King" of France, presented on an integral square plinth. The portrait captures the monarch in an idealised classical manner, with his recognisable long, flowing curls, composed expression, and regal bearing rendered in crisp relief.

The white plaster surface lends the piece the appearance of a traditional sculptor's study or atelier cast, while the architectural simplicity of the square plinth gives it a confident, decorative presence. Its contrast of elaborate Baroque portraiture and restrained mid-century presentation makes it particularly versatile: equally at home in a classical interior, a library, a study, or a more contemporary decorative scheme.

Louis XIV's image became one of the most enduring symbols of French royal grandeur, and busts of the king have long been used as emblems of taste, history, and decorative classicism. This example offers that same sense of drama and refinement in a tactile, sculptural form.

A handsome decorative object for collectors of classical revival interiors, French-inspired furnishings, portrait busts, or mid-century design. Displayed on a mantel, console, bookcase, or pedestal, it would make a distinguished focal point in any room.
