Description

A vibrant mid-century pressed ruby-glass dining service, dating to circa 1950, comprising twelve dinner plates, six side plates, and a matching water jug. With its rich, jewel-like red colour and crisp moulded detailing, the service brings immediate warmth and character to a table setting.

Made in pressed glass, each piece combines practical, robust construction with the decorative appeal that made coloured tableware so popular in the mid-20th century. The ruby hue is especially striking when caught by daylight or candlelight, creating a lively play of colour across the table. The matching jug completes the set beautifully and makes this an unusually versatile service for entertaining.

Ideal for a festive dinner table, summer luncheon, or an eclectic interior, the service can be used as a complete suite or incorporated into a wider collection of coloured glass. Its generous number of dinner plates makes it particularly appealing for entertaining, while the smaller side plates lend themselves to bread, salad, dessert, or cake service.
