

Victorian 9ct Rose Gold Cabochon White Sapphire Buckle Ring,

Description

A charming late-Victorian buckle ring in warm 9ct rose gold, hallmarked for Birmingham, 1899. The band is designed as a belt fastened through a buckle, a romantic and enduring motif traditionally associated with loyalty, connection, and an unbroken bond.

At its centre sits a softly domed cabochon white sapphire, bezel-set to emphasise its smooth, luminous surface. Rather than the sharp faceting of a brilliant-cut stone, the cabochon has a gentle, glassy glow that complements the ring's intimate scale and the mellow rosy tone of the gold. The buckle's considered detailing and flowing, wearable profile give it a wonderfully tactile quality.

An evocative piece of Victorian jewellery, equally appealing as a collectable antique ring, a meaningful token of affection, or an unusual alternative engagement or stacking ring. Its clearly dated Birmingham hallmark anchors the piece to the final year of the 19th century.
