Description

A stylish Art Deco silver plate cocktail shaker by the renowned Sheffield silversmiths Walker & Hall, dating to circa 1925. With its clean, tapering form and restrained geometric detailing, this handsome piece captures the glamour and confidence of the Jazz Age.

The shaker has a pleasingly balanced silhouette, rising from a broad circular base to a fitted cover, designed for both elegant presentation and practical use. Its bright silver-plated finish gives it a smart, reflective presence, while the streamlined shape reflects the modern taste that defined cocktail culture during the 1920s. Built for an era of fashionable entertaining, it would have been at home on a sophisticated drinks trolley or among the barware of an Art Deco interior.

Walker & Hall was one of Britain's most respected manufacturers of silver and silver plate, known for producing well-made tableware and decorative objects of enduring quality. This cocktail shaker is a fine example of the firm's ability to combine utility with stylish contemporary design.

A charming and usable survivor from the golden age of the cocktail, it would make a wonderful addition to an Art Deco collection, a home bar, or a display of early 20th-century silver plate. Its elegant form and period character also make it an excellent gift for a cocktail enthusiast or collector.
