The motifs often symbolise protection, fertility, and daily village life, reflecting centuries-old cultural heritage. Sinan kilims are distinctive for their fine weaving technique and rich symbolism. Artisans pass down skills through generations, preserving the authenticity of the craft.

Collectors and decorators value them for their rustic charm and artistic depth. These kilims represent not just decor but a living piece of Anatolian history and identity.
